Project Profile: Air Products Hydrogen Plant II

Park Derochie was awarded the insulation contract for the supply and installation of insulation for Air Products' Hydrogen plant in Strathcona County. The scope of work included the insulation of the inlet / outlet pigtails, associated duct work, piping and ancillary equipment.



Hydrogen plants are very specialized in nature and require a skilled insulation contractor that possesses the necessary experience to perform the intricate sheet metal and complex geometry detail that are often required.

Park Derochie supplied a combination of sheet metal workers and insulators in conjunction with a skilled management team; the work was completed safely, on time and within budget.
