Husky Energy – Hardisty Tank Farm



Blended heavy crude oil and bitumen from heavy oil operations and synthetic crude oil from the upgrading operations are shipped from Lloydminster via Husky's Mainline pipeline to Hardisty, Alberta, to connect with the Enbridge, Kinder Morgan (Express), InterPipeline Fund (IPF) and the TransCanada Keystone pipelines. These pipelines transport the oil to markets in eastern Canada and the United States. In 2009, additional storage tanks were commissioned at the Hardisty Terminal, increasing storage capacity at the facility to 2.26 mmbbls.

- Roof coating and external shells of four large diameter tanks

Tanks

- 4 – 210 ft. diameter tanks

Challenges

- Late season start
- Weather
- Operational interruptions

Outcome

- Zero LTAs in 13,000 hours
- Overall 85+% completion at season end
- Coating on all tanks at season end
